Some of the things you can do to help preserve the environment and reduce our dependence on imported oil are:



In your Community

- Get involved with programs that promote alternative fuels and alternative fuel vehicles;
- Attend educational workshops;
- Join the Gold Coast Clean Cities Coalition;
- Walk, ride a bicycle, carpool, and/or use public transportation;
- Drive (rent or buy) hybrid and alternative and flex fuel vehicles, since they consume less petroleum gasoline and emit less pollutants;
- Avoid rapid accelerations and braking;
- When picking up children at school, turn off the engine and wait until they are in the vehicle to restart;
- On the highway, use your cruise control and overdrive gears.





At Home

- Recycle plastic as much as possible, which reduces the production of new oil-based products;
- Buy plastic-free products if possible;
- Ride your bike or walk whenever possible;
- Purchase all-natural lipglosses or lipstick, some lipsticks are made with petroleum products;
- Air dry your clothes, since it takes petroleum to produce the electricity;
- Use moisturizers and lotions made from natural plants;
- If you are taking medicine and/or vitamins that are capsules, ask your physician if they can be changed to a caplet or tablet. Petroleum is used to make capsules;
- Use natural pest control as many pesticides contain petroleum-based chemicals.
